In February, I asked the Planning and Budget Committee to analyze ideas put forth by the Budget Options Group and make additional recommendations to reduce expenditures to address the shortfall. Chancellor's Cabinet reviewed the findings, along with input from the campus community and public, and either accepted, rejected or modified the recommendations.
