White paper, pencil, Styrofoam plate (or other clean flat piece of Styrofoam), ballpoint pen, washable markers, white cardstock, sponge, paper towels.

*You can also use scratch foam designed for printmaking, available at art supply stores such as Dick Blick.

Prepare your Styrofoam. Cut off any edges that are sticking out, so that foam is flat. Cut the foam to the shape and size you want for your print.



Your prints will be a mirror image of your design, so letters need to be written backwards to come out correctly on the print.

Use a ballpoint pen to draw your design on piece of foam. The pen will push the foam down.

Color over the entire surface of the foam with a washable marker. Make sure to color over the lines you made in the previous step!
