- 1) Election of the Faculty Senate

- 2) The Dean/Director's Office should inform the Faculty Senate of the following:
 - Tenure-track, research, and other appointments
 - Faculty Senate, and may participate in the process of appointment
 - Faculty Senate should be consulted on all appointments
 - primary appointments are determined as follows:
 - Faculty with joint appointments (i.e., appointments shared between two or more units) are represented in the Faculty Senate by the unit in which the faculty member is primarily appointed and should be represented in the Faculty Senate by the unit in which the faculty member is primarily appointed.
 - In accordance with the Faculty Senate's policies, the Faculty Senate should be consulted on all appointments to research positions.
 - Faculty with appointments to research positions should be represented in the Faculty Senate by the unit in which the faculty member is primarily appointed.
